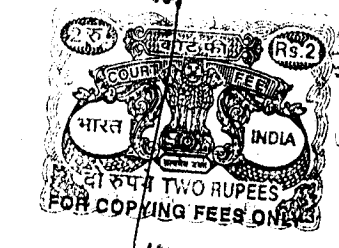

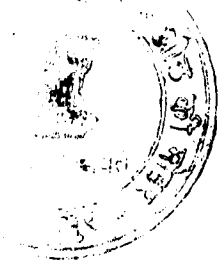

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is ready to deposit 25% of the demand of the stamp duty made by the respondents within 10 days from today, subject to the contentions raised by him in the petition.

Having regard to the said submission, it is directed that no coercive action pursuant to the impugned order shall be taken against the petitioner if the petitioner deposits 25% of the demand made by the respondents within 10 days i.e. on or before 7.9.15 before this court. However it is clarified that if the petitioner succeeds in the petition, the said amount shall be refunded by the respondents with interest @ 6% per annum from the date of deposit till refund. Put up on 9.9.15 as prayed for. The application stands disposed of accordingly.
