This writ petition has been filed against the orders dated 7.7.2004 passed by the Additional Collector, (Stamps) and 26.9.2011 passed by the Rajasthan Tax Board, Ajmer. Both the courts below have declined the request made by the petitioner. On perusal of the said order, particularly passed by the Additional Collector (Stamps), it is revealed that it has taken into account the department notice and other orders passed in similar cases by the Board of Revenue and has come to the conclusion that appropriate order be passed in respect of recovery of the remaining amount. The said finding in the order passed by the Additional Collector (Stamps) has been upheld by the Rajasthan Tax Board after considering the matter in detail

After considering the material on record, this court is of the opinion that no case for exercising extraordinary jurisdiction under the Constitution of India is made out and the impugned orders do not call for any interference.

Consequently, the writ petition is dismissed.
